

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Back ground: During the visit of Hon'ble Secretary, MSDE visit on 03.10.22 at this Institute, he has advised to set up India International Skill Centre as a finishing school for the aspirants going abroad seeking better employment with NSDC collaboration.

Accordingly, NSDC team proposed for a meeting on 22.11.2022 at Chennai as they were pre-occupied. The following members were present

Shri G.C. Ramamurthy, Joint Director welcomed all the members and brief about the background of the meeting.

Shri T.V. Rajasekar, Deputy Director briefed about institute activities with Power point presentations followed by the visit to the laboratories/workshop in the campus.

Following points were deliberated and action plan is as below:

- a) Shri Maneesh Mishra, Executive Vice President, NSDC elaborated about SIIC and SIIN and deliberated the points of the meeting held at New Delhi with MSDE and DGT officials and the Setting up of Skill International Study Centre at NSTI's, and NSTI Chennai was selected on pilot basis for implementation. He also emphasised about the talent pool in India but high-level proficiency in English, German and Japanese is the need of the hour and NSDC has identified Cambridge University Press for English proficiency Trainers of Training and Assessment.

- b) Shri T.K. Arunachalam briefed about the importance of English language requirement in countries like Australia, Singapore and New Zealand and Mr Tyagi highlighted that approximately 2500 sq.ft space is required for classroom/practical, Library and facilitation centre.
- c) Regional Director expressed that creating independent infrastructure will take time and opined that some of the class room and other part of labs can be spared initially.

Members after going through the campus that existing Distance Learning Programme (DLP) Lab and part of the library situated in the first floor of NSTI Chennai can be spared and the same was agreed by RDSDE.

Action Plan: Shri Maneesh Mishra and team agreed to carry out the refurbishment as per the details from the Cambridge University team with their fund and RDSDE has agreed to relocate the trainees to the adjacent lab to accommodate the centre.

- d) The team from KPMG also highlighted the importance Trade testing certification for the aspirants with the available workshops and labs at Chennai.

Regional Director insisted that the proposal for SIIC is to be carried out based on the specific requirement from SIIN (Skill India International Network)


Regional Director also highlighted that as NCVET has recognized DGT as a sole "awarding body" and sole "assessment body" and will award certificate to trainees who have been trained in NSTIs. Accordingly, certificates will be issued for the candidates.

The team agreed for further meeting to discuss the modalities for setting up SIIC after the approval from DGT regarding certification, cost for operation, training, testing and for other modalities, and applicable charges to be collected from the aspirants, accordingly MOU is to be signed with all terms and conditions.
